Youth who are in foster care or extended foster care who are pregnant and parenting.

### What services does NAPP provide?

Program staff help youth:

- Achieve a healthy and successful pregnancy
- Provide proper care to their child and eliminate maltreatment
- Prevent subsequent pregnancy
- Achieve educational goals
- Plan for the future through financial advisement and training

### History of NAPP

The Center for the Study of Social Policy (CSSP) had a vision of improving the outcomes of parenting youth in foster care in Knoxville and three other cities. The Department of Children's Services was awarded a grant for this project, and Child & Family Tennessee was selected as the sub-awardee.

### NAPP's vision

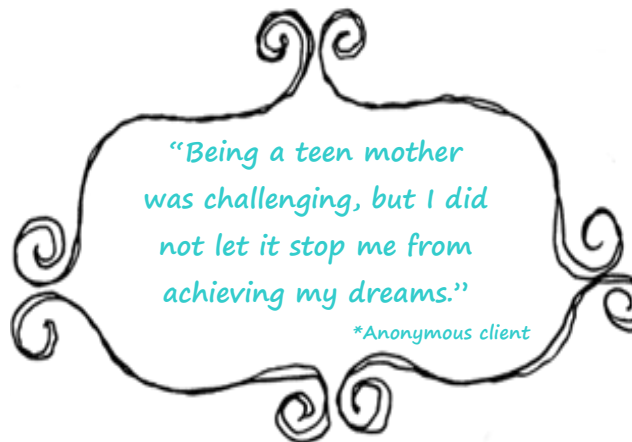
This program will offer participants the opportunity to contribute to the development and practice of this new and innovative program.



## Peer Mentor



A peer mentor will be the youth's first contact when seeking resources and support regarding pregnancy and parenting. They will work together to create an individual success plan, which will be used to determine the youth's needs and create goals for success. The mentor will serve a supportive role throughout the youth's pregnancy and parenting process until the youth feels confident she can successfully parent.

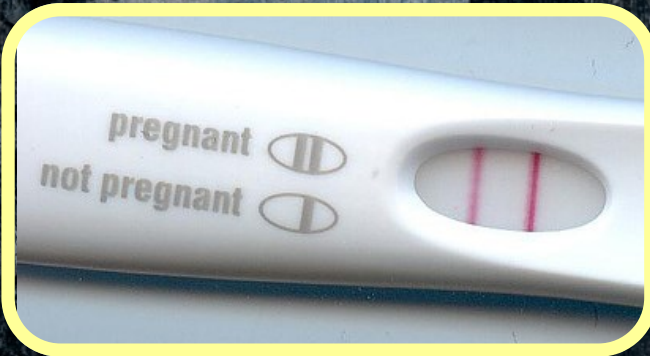
